THE RACE:

The field is limited to 7,000 runners, and registration typically closes early in January. However, in support of the RRCA Convention, CUCB has agreed to provide **guaranteed race entry** for all those who **register for the RRCA Convention by February 21**. Mark the box on the convention registration form, and a special race entry form will be sent to you; it must be returned to CUCB with the race entry fee (\$25) by **March 8** in order to qualify. Buses will provide transportation from the convention to the CUCB Expo and Packet Pick-up on Saturday afternoon (or take Metro), and there will also be bus service on Sunday morning to get you to and from the race. If you aren't able to run, you can also sign up on the race site to volunteer; that entitles you to a guaranteed entry for 2004!

ROOM RESERVATIONS & THE HOTEL:

The DoubleTree Hotel (300 Army Navy Drive in Arlington) is convenient and affordable! Free shuttle service is provided from both Washington Reagan National Airport, and also from the Pentagon City Metro Station.
